Basia ad te mitto - I send kisses to you

Basia tibi do - I give kisses to you

Laetus(a) sum si laetus (a) es - I am happy if you are happy

Ab amicō (ā) - from your friend

Tē amo sicut musca vexandum amat. I love you just as a fly loves annoying.

Musca amat esse vexans. – A fly loves to be annoying.

Ego tecum communicare amo. - I love to communicate with you

Laetus dies amoris. – Happy love day!

Tibi meum cor do. – I give my heart to you

Tē complectere amem. – I would like to hug you.

Exibisne mecum? -- Will you go out with me?
